California Journeys at Heritage Hill

The California Journeys tours at Heritage Hill Historical Park are rapidly approaching. Over 80 volunteer spots are open between January and May. Speakers and assistants will be needed to guide fourth graders through nine tour dates of the Philharmonic's California Journeys program.

**A total of eight volunteers are needed for each tour
four speakers and four assistants, from 9:00 to 11:30 A.M.**

Assistants guide a small group of students and their chaperone through four historic sites at the park: the Native American Village, the Serrano Adobe, the Victorian School House, and the Bennett Farmhouse. Speakers are stationed at one of the four sites and give a quick 10-minute overview of the highlights and historic significance of each site. Scripts are emailed in advance.

A great introduction to the program is to sign up to be an assistant. We are also offering a training/refresher for those wanting to preview the program. Groups from individual committees are encouraged to sign up together.
